History

In 2013 Little Life Pre-Primary school was started, with a passion for education and seeing little lives changed. The Pre-Primary has grown from strength to strength. It was started with just 3 children, and now we have over 90 children. We have seen amazing growth in both the children and staff on our property.

Little Life Pre-Primary is making a significant impact in our community, offering education at a very high standard in a secure, happy and safe environment where children are encouraged to explore the world around them through outdoor play and fun. Our little lives are so happy here that we saw a need to keep growing and start a Primary School.

In 2018, a small team, with a passion and drive to see a Christian Private School opened in the Amanzimtoti area, started preparations and planning to see this dream become a reality and in 2020 the first Grade 1 class was launched. Prescient means "to have foreknowledge". It is our desire that we equip learners for an everchanging future and as much as we are not able to predict the future, our hope is that our students develop a sound understanding of the world around them and are able to succeed in every area of life in an ever-changing and developing world.

In 2022, Mrs Jessica Ratcliffe was appointed as Principal of the Prescient Private Academy, which includes Little Life Pre-Primary and Prescient Primary School. We now offer Grades 1 - 4 in 2023 and from January 2024, we will have Grades 1 - 7 available.

Buildings

The current facilities include the following:

- A large hall (air-conditioned) which is used for assembly and indoor play area
- 4 large air-conditioned classrooms for Grade 1,2,3 & Grade 4
- Bathrooms
- A playground and sports field
- A Coffee-shop and additional toilets
- We have indoor and outdoor toys and resources which will be used to develop a number of skills in a fun and exciting way
- Large swings for both children and staff to enjoy together

We rent an off-site swimming pool for swimming lessons

Additional land has been earmarked and conceptual building plans for the new school building to be built have already been drawn up. This will require continued fundraising to make this concept a reality in the years to come.

Class Size

Prescient Primary School prides itself with small classes. Lower grades 1-3 enjoy access to 1 qualified teacher per class as well as a teacher's assistant. Grades 4-7 will have a qualified teacher per class.

Curriculum

Our school curriculum is CAPS aligned according to the departmental standards, however, we strive for a higher standard by using International resources and curricula. We use resources that are rated amongst the best in the world, such as the Cambridge, Singapore and Oxford curriculums, starting from Grade R and up to our highest grade.

Assessments

Our school follows a continuous assessment programme. This is achieved by daily verbal assessment between teacher and student, as well as weekly and termly written assessments. Formal examination setting only begins in Grade 7, as we prepare them for their next phase of schooling being High School.

Sports & Co-Curriculars

Our school is a member of the KZN Christian Schools Sports Association (KZNCSSA) which affords our learners the opportunity to engage with other Independent Christian schools in terms of sports tournaments and matches. Our learners are privileged to experience tournaments/matches/races at all the big sports stadiums

in KZN. We are proud to be the only school in Amanzimtoti whose learners are invited to compete at district, provincial and national levels from the age of 6 upwards.

We have an extensive co-curricular offering which includes Choir, Chess, Art Club, Skill Building and Coding.

School Fees

Non-payment of fees:

To ensure the effective running of the school, and in the best interest of pupils and other parents, it is essential that the prescribed terms of payment are strictly adhered to.

- 1. Pupils whose fees are outstanding equivalent to two months' fees will not be permitted to return to school in the next term.
- 2. Any pupil whose fee account reflects a balance outstanding at the end of the academic year will not be admitted back to school in the first term of the following year.
- 3. Money paid to the school for any additional fees such as outings, events, etc. will be allocated to school fees first.
- 4. Legal action may be taken if payment is not made on time.
- 5. All non-payment incidents will be kept strictly confidential.

Parents/guardians are to give one term' written notice if their children will be leaving the school.

School Hours

Prescient Primary School is open from Mondays to Fridays except during school holidays and public holidays.

- 1. School opens at 07:00
- 2. School hours:

- 3. Co-curriculars are run within the normal school day and are compulsory for all learners.
- 4. Aftercare is offered from after school until 17:00 (excluded from school fees)
- 5. Optional extra-murals may be run after 14:00

Injuries

The safety of your child is one of our number one priorities, however, should injuries occur our staff are more than capable of administering first aid.

Our staff are trained and updated routinely in first aid and will be able to administer first aid where necessary - first aid certificates are available for your perusal on request. A fully-stocked first aid box will always be at hand. Please let us know on the enrolment form if your child has any allergies.

Meals

All children are required to bring their own bottles of water and juice. No soda or energy drinks will be permitted.

We encourage parents to pack healthy, nutritious lunches. Sugary treats will be sent back to enjoy at home.

The Coffee Shop on site provides wholesome lunches for our learners which can be ordered and paid daily for via the KARRI App.

Admission Procedure

This admissions procedure adheres to the South African Schools act and to the principles contained in the constitution, as well as to other applicable legislation.

Preference will be given to the Grade R learners at Little Life Pre-Primary.

 When the application forms have been completed, kindly submit it together with all the required documentation to Prescient Primary School together with the application fee of R500. This can be done via email to <u>admin@prescientprimary.co.za</u> or can be hand delivered to the admissions officer.

- 2. If the child meets the admission requirements, then an interview or 1 day assessment for kids coming into Grade 2 and higher, will be scheduled with the parents/guardians and with the child.
- 3. During the interview process, the child may be asked to complete a few assessments which shall enable us to assess their readiness.
- 4. If the interview is successful, the parents/guardians will receive a fee agreement and an enrolment form.
- 5. The parents/guardians must then complete the following:
 - a. Read and sign the enrolment form (includes fee agreement);
 - b. Pay the registration fee (See Fee Schedule);
 - c. Pay the first month's installment of the annual school fees (See Fee Schedule).
- 6. Once the enrolment form has been signed and the registration fee as well as the first month's installment of the annual school fees has been paid then the child will start at Prescient Primary School.
- 7. Kindly take note that applications will be accepted even if the school is full. If the application is successful, then the child will be put onto a waiting list and the parents will be advised accordingly.
